2. Candidates are invited to apply for the Zobha Grace of Giving Scholarship by:
 - a. Completing essay questions provided by Zobha
 - b. Submitting a short video answering questions provided by Zobha
 - c. Providing a copy of the Pure Teacher Training program acceptance letter
 - d. Providing a letter of recommendation from a yoga teacher with whom you have studied
3. Recipient must be willing to collaborate with Zobha on sharing their teacher training experience.
